Situation

Botswana is a land-locked country dominated in geographical terms by the Kalahari Desert - a sand-filled basin averaging 1,100 meters above sea level. The country lies between longitudes 20 and 30 degrees east of Greenwich and between the latitudes 18 and 27 degrees approximately south of the Equator. Botswana is surrounded by Namibia, South Africa, Zambia and Zimbabwe. Slightly larger than France and almost the size of Texas, the landmass covers 581 730 square kilometres (224 607 square miles).

Languages

English is the official language, while Setswana is the most widely spoken African language.

Religion

Early tribal religions were primarily cults. The supreme being and creator was known as the Modimo. Religious rites included the bogwera and bojale (male and female initiation ceremonies) and gofethla pula or rain-making rites. Today, Christianity is the prevailing belief system (well over 60% of the population). Christianity was brought to Botswana by David Livingstone in the 19th Century. The main denominations are Roman Catholic, Anglican, Zion, Lutheran and the Methodist Christian Church.

The People

The population of Botswana is made up of people from approximately 20 different tribes, some of which came originally from Botswana's neighbouring countries: South Africa, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Angola and Namibia. Ethnic groups in Botswana are predominately made up of Tswana people (79 %) and split up among eight tribes. The others include Bamangwato, Bakwena, Bangwaketsi, Bakgatla, Barolong, Bamalete, and Batlokwa. The next largest single group of indigenous peoples is the Kalanga, which accounts for about 11% of the population and there are approximately 3% Basarwa (Bushmen). Kgalagadi and whites account for about 7%. Through the centuries, as people of the different tribes joined, they shared many of their customs.

Today, all of these different customs and beliefs help make up the culture of Botswana, as well as influences from non-African places because Botswana today is a modern country. The people of Tswana origin and also the citizens of the country are called Bastswana or Motswana. The language of Botswana is Setswana, and the word is also used to describe the way of life.

Climate

Botswana's climate is semi-arid. Though it is hot and dry for much of the year, there is a rainy season, which runs through the summer months. Rainfall tends to be erratic, unpredictable and highly regional. Often a heavy downpour may occur in one area while 10 or 15 kilometres away there is no rain at all. Rain typically falls in short thundershowers in the late afternoon. Showers are often followed by strong sunshine so that a good deal of the rainfall does not penetrate the ground but is lost to evaporation and transpiration. Rainfall is low (approximately 470 mm / 18.5 in) per year and phrases like "rainy season" should be seen in context.

SECRETS OF TRAVEL IN THE GREEN SEASON REVEALED

Conventional wisdom states that the dry seasons are the best times to visit Africa, with the game dependent on ever-shrinking waterholes and more concentrated, so that sightings are better. With vegetation withering, even smaller creatures can be easier to spot. However, with safari holidays becoming more popular, this emphasis on each region's dry season means that travellers couldn't always escape from the crowds and even the most luxurious lodges often operate at capacity.

The Green Season – that is, the time when the bush comes alive during and after the rains – was often overlooked or dismissed as "not the right time" to go to Africa on holiday. Those in the know, however, referred to it as the Secret Season and like all the best secrets, it was worth keeping.

Let's quickly get the disadvantages of green season travel out of the way. Yes, you're more likely to get rained on (although it will probably be a short cloudburst rather than a sustained downpour, and given that it's summer, we're talking pleasantly warm rain). Yes, the wildlife will have dispersed somewhat and with plants growing at a furious pace, they'll have more places to hide. And yes, there may be more bugs than usual and the humidity will be higher.

With a little careful planning, and a spirit of adventure, we believe that the Green Season can be one of the very best times to visit Africa on safari – and now Journey Beyond can reveal its secrets.






CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Chobe National Park is in northern Botswana near the vast, inland Okavango Delta. It's known for its large herds of elephants and Cape buffalo, which converge along the Chobe Riverfront in the dry months. Lions, antelopes and hippos inhabit the woods and lagoons around Linyanti Marsh. The floodable grasslands of the Savuti Marsh attract numerous bird species, plus migrating zebras.










SAVUTE

Savute is tucked away within the spectacular Chobe National Park in Botswana, and stretches all along the northern boundaries of the park to the Linyanti River. Savute was dry and waterless for almost 3 decades, and artificial waterholes nourished the wildlife. Now up and running again, it offers an excellent base for Botswana safari tours.









MOREMI WILDLIFE RESERVE & OKAVANGO REGION

Moremi Game Reserve is in northern Botswana, in the Okavango Delta, which becomes a lush animal habitat during seasonal floods. Dugout canoes are used to navigate past birdlife, hippos and crocodiles on waterways like the Xakanaxa Lagoon. On land, wildlife includes lions, leopards and rhinos. Safari camps are common, with several dotted around large Chief's Island and the forested Mopane Tongue Peninsula.










CENTRAL KALAHARI GAME RESERVE

This is the largest and by far the most remote reserve in Southern Africa. It covers and area of 52000 square km and makes the Central Kalahari the second largest reserve in the world.









MAKGADIKGADI PANS GAME RESERVE

The Makgadikgadi Pans Game Reserve, a salt pan— with an area of 3 900 sq. kms is situated in the middle of the dry savanna of north-eastern Botswana. It is one of the largest salt flats in the world. The pan is all that remains of the formerly enormous Lake Makgadikgadi.


